Date and Time:

July 15, 2006 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

You **MUST** complete your participation in the College Coaches' Expo **BEFORE** you register for the Nationals. Clay Court Registration is from 1:15 pm. – 5:00 p.m. on July 15, 2006.

Location:

Grand Ballroom – DoubleTree Hotel

Eligibility:

All college bound student athletes that have completed their junior year in high school as of July 1, 2006 may participate in the Expo. This includes players who are in the Clay Court Championships as well as alternates.

What Schools Will Be Participating?

Event Summary:

The 3rd Annual College Coaches Expo has been organized primarily for the college bound student athlete in mind. We hope that the atmosphere is non-intimidating, casual and a place where you can come and meet with coaches and learn about collegiate programs you are interested in.

When you check in at the Expo, you will receive a nametag that includes your name, USTA Section and hometown. Your parents will not receive a nametag, but they are welcome to participate with you. The coaches have already received a list of all players in The Clay Courts as well as those on the National Tournament Alternate List. The list includes your name, address, birth date, e-mail address and USTA Section.

All colleges participating in the Expo will be set up at tables in the Grand Ballroom. Schools will have one or more of their coaches there for you to speak

with and will be providing you with information on their tennis and academic programs.

Please do not register for the Clay Courts on July 15th until you have finished participating in the Expo. Tournament Registration closes at 3:15 p.m. for Boys' 18s, 5:00 p.m. for Boys' 16s Singles and 6:30 p.m. for Doubles.
